

10 Printing Commandments

- Print duplex.
- Print black and white.
- III- Select draft mode printing and use smaller font.
- When printing PowerPoints, print handouts of 3-6 slides per page. Disconsider colored backgrounds!
- V- If possible, submit assignments online.
- VI- Use print preview before sending the job, so you won't have to print it again.
- VII- If it doesn't print immediately, do not send it again. Wait and ask for support.
- VIII- Print only the amount of copies you really need.
- IX- If you print something you don't need, reuse it, or give it to someone else who will.
- X- Avoid taking paper from the printer for personal use.
