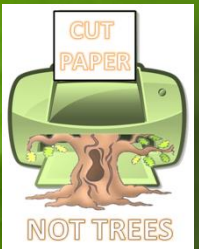


To Print or Not to Print? That is a Wise Question!

- In March, we used **~1.6 reams** of paper (**800 sheets**).



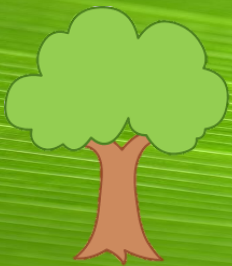

- We wasted a total of **104 sheets** = 12.5% of the total amount used. This is about 0.2 % of a tree!



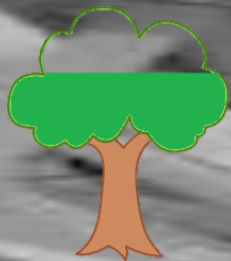

10 Printing Commandments

- I-** Print duplex.
- II-** Print black and white.
- III-** Select draft mode printing and use smaller font.
- IV-** When printing PowerPoints, print handouts of 3-6 slides per page. Disconsider colored backgrounds!
- V-** If possible, submit assignments online.
- VI-** Use print preview before sending the job, so you won't have to print it again.
- VII-** If it doesn't print immediately, do not send it again. Wait and ask for support.
- VIII-** Print only the amount of copies you really need.
- IX-** If you print something you don't need, reuse it, or give it to someone else who will.
- X-** Avoid taking paper from the printer for personal use.
